peace war crimes and crimes against humanity as well as the crimes of conspiracy and membership in a criminal organization the fourth section then examines the modes of participation and defenses that the tribunals recognized the final section deals with sentencing the aftermath of the trials and their historical legacy

towards the close of world war ii world leaders had to address the question of what to do with alleged war criminals in 1945 an international military tribunal imt was established to see that war criminals would face justice this collection of essay

entries address topics related to genocide crimes against humanity and peace and human rights violations profile perpetrators including joseph stalin pol pot and idi amin and discuss institutions set up to prosecute these crimes in countries around the world
